- Represents business debtors and creditors in chapter 11 bankruptcy, as well as litigants in a broad range of commercial disputes.
- Obtained a summary judgment in bankruptcy court dismissing \$12 million in fraudulent transfer and unjust enrichment claims in a complex data center construction dispute.
